

### **Setting the Table for Thanksgiving**



Help us help others next Sunday by decorating the front of the sanctuary with foods of the harvest for the Parkdale Food Bank. Please bring your gifts of apples, pumpkins, squash, onions, peppers, zucchini,

tomatoes, bags of lentils and pasta, cans of spaghetti sauce and soup and place them at the communion table. They will be delivered to the Food Bank on Tuesday morning. **AWARENESS FOUNDATION:** On the weekend of October 24th, Rev. Dr. Nadim Nassar will be visiting Parkdale United Church once again. Father Nadim is the first Syrian Anglican Minister in the UK and the founder of the **Awareness Foundation**, an international humanitarian Christian charity which builds peace through education. He is also the author of two books: The Culture of God and iJesus.

In addition to Father Nadim speaking at Parkdale's Sunday service on October 26th, we have the opportunity to hear him speak and share about the Artwork and the situation in the middle East on two occasions: on Saturday October 25th, 2-5pm, Parkdale will host an art exhibit entitled "Stations of Peace." This event will showcase artwork by Syrian children who have been helped by the **Awareness Foundation**, offering a glimpse into their lived experiences, memories, and dreams. Father Nadim will also speak on behalf of their organization. This event will not have an admission fee, but an entry donation is encouraged. Refreshments will be served. Prints of the Syrian children's art pieces will be available for purchase. All proceeds will go to the work of the Awareness Foundation, a registered charity in the UK, working in Syria and the Middle East. All are welcome. Donations to the Awareness Foundation are welcome.

On Sunday, Oct. 26th from 12-2 PM, Parkdale will host a Middle Eastern Lunch. This event will also showcase the artwork by Syrian Children and an opportunity to hear an update about the situation in Syria. Registration is required for the luncheon. Tickets are \$20 per person and \$60 per family. Please contact Huda to register. All are welcome. Childcare available.
