- **Quiet Walk** – A gentle walk ~15-minute for prayer, reflection, or simply enjoying God's presence in nature.

- **Pause & Reflect** – Share insights, journal, sketch, or quietly observe your surroundings (~20 mins)
- **Sensory Walk** – Notice God's creation through what you see, hear, smell, feel, and wonder about (~15mins).
- **Connect & Create** – Help create a simple nature-inspired community art piece (without disturbing the environment), followed by light refreshments and fellowship. (~45minutes)
